C	<u>The Order of Creation</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> God uses the first 3 days to create time, space, and life; and the next 3 days to create light, birds and fish, animals and human beings; each controls the previous three respectively. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Time (Day & night) 2. Space (Sky and water are separated) 3. Life (Plants) 4. Sun / Moon to control day and night 5. Birds and fish to fill the sky and water 6. D	<u>Understanding Creation in Seven Days</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Have you ever wondered why day and night are created on the first day before the creation of the sun and moon on the 4th day? This shows that the creation story recorded in scripture is not to be read as a scientific explanation. The Church never meant for us to interpret the seven days of creation as 7/24. In the early 20th century, the Church disagreed with the fundamentalists in the State who interpreted Gen 1-3 from a purely scientific perspective by adopting Biblical Literalism. On the other hand, the Church is not suggesting that we should read Gen 1-11 as pure myths. We must read it from the perspective of “the new is hidden in the old and the old is revealed in the new”. F	<u>The Sixth Day: Human Beings and Beasts at the Same Level?</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> “Six” represents “beastly” according to Jewish traditions. Human beings, created in the image of God, are different from the animals as a human being is the unity of soul and flesh, thus, he/she has the need to worship God. On the seventh day, the Sabbath, it’s a day for God; a day of holiness. Though both human beings and animals are created on the 6th day, human 	SH 4 SH 5

"Seven" = God's Promise; God established a covenant with humankind to form a family and become relatives.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> In the creation of the world, God uses Sabbath as the day of worship and in so doing, sanctifies time; the universe becomes His Temple that sanctifies space; the whole creation is a covenant.
