

2007-08 BSP#9 Group Time Discussion

L – Low, M – Medium, and H – High, indicate the difficulty of a question. Group leaders should select questions that are challenging to their groups but not so difficult that their group members cannot answer.

(A) “He Opened to Us the Scriptures” – Scripture-Related Questions for Reflection and Discussion (Time available: 15 minutes. Do at least 2 questions.)

1. [M] Read Gen 6:11-13. What was it that caused God such grief over men?
2. [L] Look at the very first thing Noah did when he got off the ark (Gen 8:20). What was it? Compare what Noah did with what Cain did in Gen 4:16. What does this difference tell us about the two persons?
3. [H] Remember that Noah’s name meant “rest.” Read 8:21-22. Did Noah live up to his name? Whom did Noah prefigure? How?

(B) “Did Not Our Hearts Burn?” – Question(s) for Group Meditation and Prayerful Reflection. (Suggested time: 15 minutes)

Noah had to wait patiently for the waters of judgment and devastation to recede. Is there a place in your life now where you must do the same? Is there anything in this lesson that will help your waiting to lead to holiness in you?
