	 To make the messages more easily memorized and distinguished, all seven messages to the churches begin with a solemn introduction by Christ himself. E.g., To the Church in Ephesus – to rekindle their love. 		
	 John's vision commences the Heavenly sacrificial liturgy. The seven letters are analogous to the penitential rite at the beginning of Mass that prunes the hearts of the faithful as they enter into the sacred liturgy. 	 Smyrna was a centre of the imperial cult. A famous martyr, St. Polycarp (d 155). 		
	• Jesus, who identifies Himself as "the first and the last, the one who lives who once died but came to live", offers comfort by assuring the Christians of Smyrna that he knows well their tribulation and poverty, and that they should put their trust in Jesus since He is the Lord eternal who has conquered death; they are rich. Reflect: Jesus also knows that they suffered persecution by the Jews. They must be briefly tested (ten days), and remain "faithful unto death", the victors "shall not be harmed by the second death", that is, "the burning pool of fire and sulfur".	1:17-18 20:14, 21:8	Dan 1:12-15

E	 To the Church in Thyatira – False Teachers Thyatira, known for its trade guilds, was a commercial and manufacturing town. Idolatrous worship, rituals often involved sexual immortality. Christians would have experienced considerable social and economic pressure to participate. Apollo, the sun god and a son of Zeus, was the chief deity of the city. Therefore, Christ presents himself as the Son of God. 	2:18-29 CCSS	
	 Jesus commends the church of Thyatira possesses the virtues of "love, faith, service, and endurance", and the members are progressing. Reflect: With "eyes like fiery flame", Jesus sees that they "tolerate the woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess, who teaches and misleads my servants to play the harlot and to eat food sacrificed to idols". 	 Sardis was rich in trades and fertile farmlands and the church was prosperous.

G	 A prosperous commercial centre. The local Jewish community persecuted the Christians. Jesus commends them that they have "kept my word and have not denied my name". Reflect: By declaring that he holds the key of David, the risen Jesus is affirming that he is the true Messiah, David's heir. The church of Christ will replace their persecutors, the Jewish community, just as Shebna, the king's steward, was replaced by Eliakim, and to receive the name of New Jerusalem. 	3:7-13 CCSS	Is 22:22
